

Grady-White Fisherman 257

Grady-White's Fisherman 257 (24'9" LOA, 8'6" beam) is designed on Grady-White's exclusive SeaV2 continuously variable vee hull and loaded with both fishing and family features. Powered by twin Yamaha 200-hp outboard engines, the 257 has a top speed of 52 mph and at 30, her cruising range is nearly 360 miles, enough for a full day of fun on the water. With a 64-square-foot, self-bailing cockpit, feature-rich transom and stand-up head, the Fisherman 257 is a class leader in the 25-foot center console market. Optional features include an anchor windlass with bow pulpit or bow roller, casting platform insert, port convenience package with battery charger and dockside power with galvanic isolator, engine flush system with hose attachment aft (one per engine), and a portable head and outrigger kit (requires optional fiberglass T-top). gradywhite.com
