

GRADY-WHITE EXPRESS 330

Recently named one of the 25 greatest sportfishing boats of the decade, the Grady-White Express 330 is a very popular and much-honored express-style design that continues to set an industry standard. The new 2015 Express 330 made its debut at the Annapolis Boat Show and the company undertook a redesign to this popular and iconic boat, building in many important upgrades to meet advances in technology and evolving customer wants and needs. Grady-White has created a new environment aboard this boat, with even better features, ergonomics and use of space, while retaining the best of its engineering details. There's enhanced seating and movement around the helm area thanks to added amenities such as improved footrests and a contoured seating option. Inside, a new lighting design brightens up the entire cabin while new cabinetry and counters in the galley along with more luxurious interior fabrics give the cabin an elegant look and feel. Other new features include the Yamaha Helm Master system.

Later in the 2015 model year Grady-White will offer an AV hardtop with a SureShade retractable cover for an out-of-the-sun cockpit. A special helm enclosure option is available in lieu of the standard hardtop and a cockpit grill and refrigerator are now available. Always keeping the angler in mind, the Express 330 offers a roomy cockpit and easily accessed rod and tackle storage as well as a large capacity live well. Improvement in movement and ergonomics at the helm and in the cockpit also enhance the boat's fishability. All storage and fish boxes are self-bailing and gunwale washdown system makes clean up a breeze.
