WHY WE LOVE IT: Soon after this hull floated onto the market, it was named Boat of the Year by SF's sister publication __Boating_._ Other experts dubbed the Express 330 a "category killer". The boat has fuel efficiency, fishing and cruising amenities as well as speed, interior space and performance. Over the years, Grady has tweaked the hull, and it remains one of the company's best-loved boats. With twin Yamaha F350s, it tops out over 50 mph; at cruise, it runs 27 mph and delivers 1.24 mpg.
