Grady-White Adventure 218

Back in 1974, Grady-White designed one of the first walkaround cabin boats. Today, that heritage lives on in the Adventure 218, a 21-footer with modern creature comforts such as cushioned helm and companion chairs, as well as cushioned fish boxes in the cockpit. Grady-White also includes two integrated swim platforms aft; they make fighting fish as easy from the stern as it is from the walkaround sides or the bow. Those same platforms are also helpful for watersports with the kids. A retractable ski pylon for wakeboarding, water skiing and tubing is optional. It's a new feature that hasn't been offered on previous walkaround boats.
