Grady-White Freedom 415

If you fish on boats it's a sure bet you're familiar with Grady-White. You've heard their boats are built as good as it gets, are laid out and rigged to fish hard, and retain their resale value like few other boats can. You heard right—and their newest offering is the **Freedom 415**. A dual console design, the 415 might seem like an unusual choice for serious anglers. Until that is, you step aboard.



The latest from Grady-White boats is the Freedom 415.

From the helmdeck back the 415 is pure fishing machine, with a huge cockpit, a big aft bait-watching seat to starboard, a tackle and rigging station to port, a pair of 35-gallon livewells, and a monstrous 115-gallon transom fishbox that's actually an integrated refrigerator/freezer. Meanwhile, the DC design provides complete all-weather protection at the helm and you still get a useable bow cockpit for when the weather's nice or the family wants to go for a cocktail cruise. The starboard-side console houses a large head compartment and the port side has a cabin with enough room for a pair of anglers to crash when the bite slows down on an overnigher.
